Personal and Social Development, Wellbeing and Cultural Diversity.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Comparing toys from the Victorian era to the toys we have today. Friction investigations using cars. Toys and games from around the world.

Language, Literacy and Communication Children will complete a variety of language activities based upon our topic, we will focus on a different writing genre each week. Our work will be based upon books from the Old Bear series, Dogger, The Velveteen Rabbit and many more.

Reading sessions will take place throughout the week; so please ensure that your child has their book bag with them every day. It would be beneficial for you to read with your child every day at home. It is also important for Nursery and Reception pupils to practise their letter sounds and formation—a Sound Book will be provided to support this learning. Homework books will be provided for Year 11&2 pupils, which will be handed out on a Friday and should be returned on a Monday.

In our class we like to listen to the pupils' ideas about what they would like to learn about. We are looking forward to hearing their brilliant ideas and including them in our classroom activities.

<u>Mathematical Development</u>

This term we will be working on number recognition, counting, addition and subtraction. We will also be estimating and measuring using different equipment. We will learn the names of 2D and 3D shapes and complete symmetrical patterns and pictures. Money maths will continue to be worked on in the class toy shop as well as through focussed activities. The concept of time will be looked at in terms of daily and weekly activities and seasons of the year.

Physical Development

Physical skills will be developed in our P.E lessons, where will be following the Physical Literacy scheme of work. P.E sessions will take place on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, please ensure that your child comes to school dressed in their P.E kit on these days.

<u>Creative Development</u>

Making puppets and other toys. Pieces of art based upon our class stories.

Creative music and drama sessions will also be taking place.

Welsh Language Development

We will continue to carry out Helpwr Heddiw session every morning, as well as develop Welsh language skills throughout the day. Children will also have the opportunity to watch the Fflic a Fflac series.
